DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – MEMBERS’ CODE OF CONDUCT

RECORD OF DECISIONS TAKEN

- 1) Members agreed to move a mobile CCTV unit to the Tesco bridge area and investigate whether a fixed CCTV unit in the town centre could be pointed to the area where fly tipping was occurring.
- 2) Members approved a tourism video to promote the area.
- 3) Members approved a feasibility study for a snooker hall, subject to funding being identified and secured.
- 4) Members agreed some business plan tasks as part of the Deputy Clerk’s forward work programme.
- 5) Members agreed to enter this year’s Wales in Bloom competition and reduce the number of town centre planters. The planters required a further assessment with the adopted businesses before any further action to enhance their appearance.
- 6) Members noted as received the fish sculpture project.
- 7) Members approved for the Council to submit an entry for Holywell into the UK town of culture competition.
- 8) Members approved a defib unit for the Strand estate. Enquiries would be made with the Top Shop and Flint and District Lions.
- 9) Members agreed to contact the County Council to rectify the street lighting on the pathway leading from the top of Greenfield Valley into Hillside Court.
